



## **TFN Enrichment Funds Education Incentive Policy**

### **1. PURPOSE:**

- 1.1 To ensure the implementation of the Education Incentive Program fund in a fair and equitable manner for the benefit of Temagami First Nation students

### **2. Goal:**

- 2.1 To recognize students for their academic achievements and good attendance.
- 2.2 Academic Achievement is not only good grades but also hard work, positive attitude and effort in school. Or
- 2.3 Good attendance is considered to be 5 days absence or less throughout the school year.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 3.1 Registered members of the Temagami First Nation currently attending a recognized educational institution on a full-time basis who are not in financial arrears with the Temagami First Nation are eligible.

### **4. ALLOCATION:**

- 4.1 Annual allocations will be in accordance with the on-going plan/budget for the Enrichment Funds Program
- 4.2 Bursary and award amounts will be based on the number of applicants, funds available and level of education completed.
- 4.3 Applications must be submitted before August 31 to be considered

### **5. PROCESS FOR REQUESTING FUNDS:**

- 5.1 Student must submit a letter written in their own words about themselves along with the following:
  - 5.2 A completed application form
  - 5.3 the student's report card(s) along with attached Completion of Requirements for Graduation for the past entire school year.
