TFN Enrichment Funds Secondary School Supplement Policy

1. PURPOSE:

- 1.1 To set out guidelines for the administration of the secondary school supplement program.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1 Registered Members of the Temagami First Nation who are Full-Time students in grades 9-12 are eligible.

3. ALLOCATION:

- 3.1 Eligible students can access up to a maximum of \$200.00 per fiscal year to assist with the expenses
- 3.2 The fiscal year is from April 1st to March 31st of the following year
- 3.3 Funding is allocated on a first come first served basis, according to the date received by the Enrichment Clerk until the budget is depleted

4. PROCESS FOR REQUESTING FUNDS:

- 4.1 Temagami First Nation members can only apply on behalf of themselves and must submit a letter (return address and phone number included) to the Enrichment Funds Clerk requesting secondary school supplement along with **ORIGINAL** receipts showing school related expenses i.e. books, supplies, clothing, graduation fees.
- 4.2 The letter must include status number and included the name, address and phone number of the school attending is required.

NOTE: Jordan's Principle for all First Nations children whom are 18 years and younger living in Canada. The funding can help with accessing products, services and support for children's needs,. Funding can help with a wide range of health, social and educational needs
